SAFETY CHECK

- Smoke detectors
- CO detectors
- Water heater set-point
- Dryer vent
- Fridge coil
- Light bulbs
- Furnace filters

BATH & KITCHEN

- Grab bars
- Shower wands
- Shower seats
- Raised toilet seats
- Faucet levers
- Drawer pulls
- Install handrails
- Change doorknobs
- Lighting

- Flooring
- Gutters
- Storm/screen doors
- Steps/existing ramps

Who Can Participate

You must meet the following four criteria:

- Be over 60 years old or have a disability
- Own your home or live in a home owned by someone in your family
- Live in Bath, West Bath, Arrowsic, Georgetown, Phippsburg, or Woolwich
- Annual household income under \$40,050 for one, \$45,800 for two, \$51,500 for three, etc.
