Rides, INC is not affiliated with the Town of Bowdoinham or with the Town of Richmond. It is an independent organization that is completely run by volunteers. Rides, In Neighbors Cars (Rides, I.N.C.) is a volunteer door-to-door and door-through door driver service.

**Goal:** To increase the independence of people who choose not to drive or who can no longer drive by matching people who need a ride with people who are willing to give a ride

### How does it work?

First time users meet with the Rides Coordinator and fill out a Riders Card to tell us more about the kinds of rides you will need from Rides, I.N.C.

We do not charge for rides. However, your donation is gratefully accepted to defer the expenses of the program. We offer our volunteer drivers mileage reimbursement. Drivers can not accept tips from their riders.

Appointments should me made 48 hours in advance. We understand that there will be times when you cannot give us 48 hours notice. When you call, we will try to find an available driver.

### Would you like to volunteer?

Volunteers are crucial to the success of Rides, INC. All of our volunteers drive their own vehicles. All volunteers must consent to a background check and attend a Volunteer Orientation session.

Volunteers are strongly encouraged to take the AARP Safe Driving Program.

- Volunteer-owned vehicles must have clean interiors be in good working order and have a current inspection sticker.
- Must have current driver's license, good driving record, and auto insurance. All volunteers must have minimum coverage required by state law and must prove it to Rides, INC.
- Must be reliable and punctual. Casual attire is acceptable.

Volunteers determine their availability and the amount of time they wish to commit to the program. Every individual's commitment is beneficial to the success of the program. Volunteers will be contacted to provide transportation only for the days and times that they have provided to Rides, INC staff, except in emergencies.
