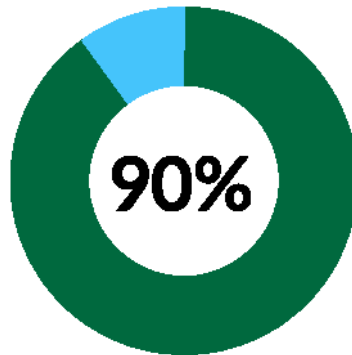

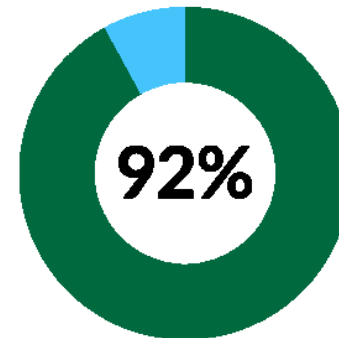


Northern New England Geriatric Workforce Enhancement Program

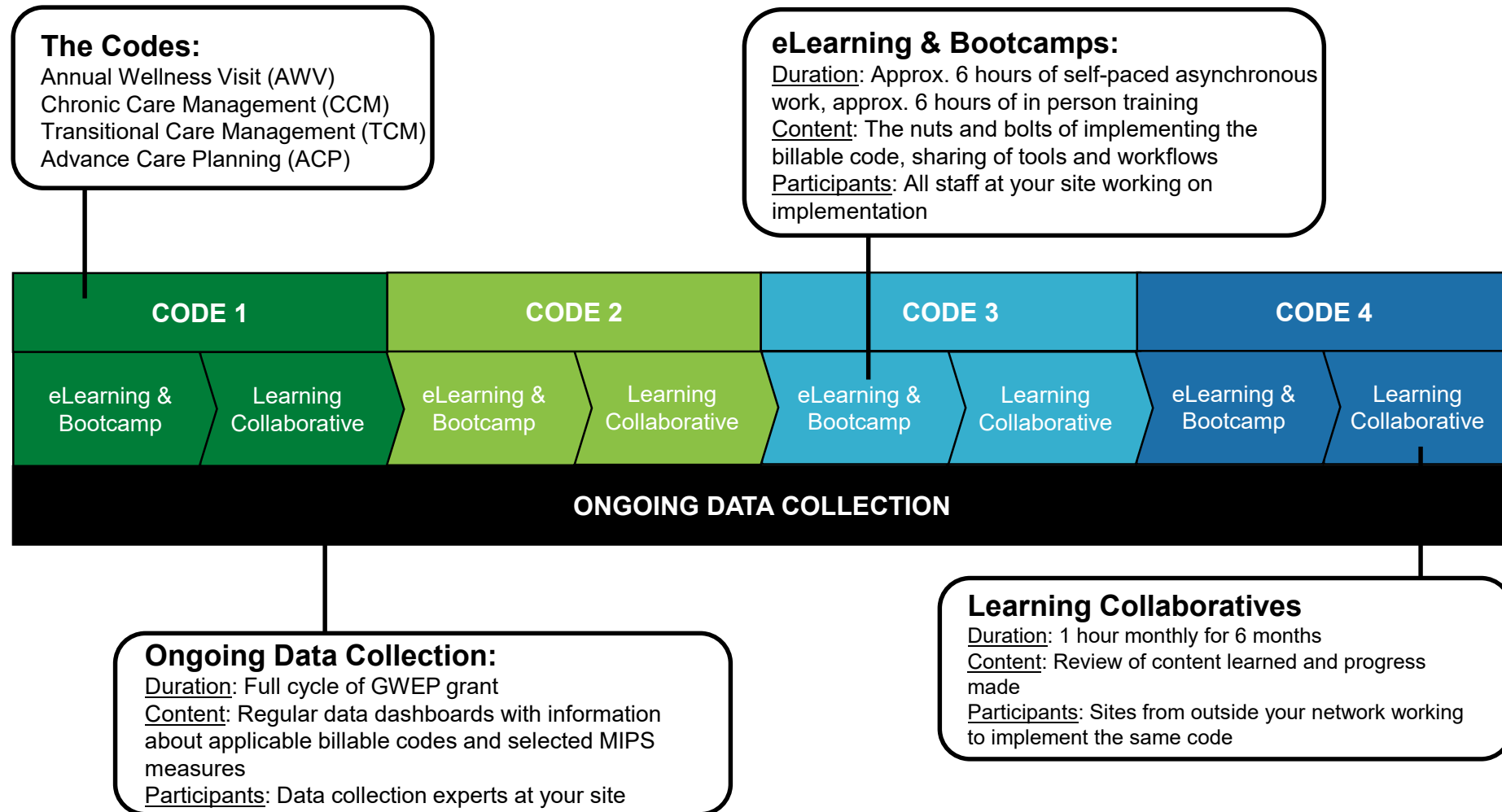
